RE: Public Hearing for CDBG 2021 Action Plan

Summary:

The FY2021 CDBG Action Plan describes in detail actions to be taken in the coming year to further the priorities described in the 2017-2021 Consolidated Plan. These projects are outlined in the attachment, and the full 2021 Action Plan is available in the City Manager's office, at the Massanutten Regional Library, and on the city's website. A 30-day public comment period was held, and during that time the city received comments from the public during the public hearing at the City Council meeting on March 23, 2021. No additional comments were received after the meeting. Staff recommends approval.

Background:

This process is required every year for CDBG compliance.

Key Issues:

As an entitlement community, the City of Harrisonburg, VA receives funding through the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). The Action Plan serves as the planning document for addressing overall community development and housing needs that will utilize the \$532,571 annual entitlement of CDBG funding available to the city to meet those needs. Projects selected to receive funding are included in the Annual Action Plan.

The CDBG selection Committee met on March 11, 2021. The attached document summarizes funding recommendations for the 2021 Action Plan. These numbers are based on the city's 2021 allocation of \$532,571.

Fiscal Impact:

This is a requirement to receive CDBG grant funding from HUD.
