Who is ALCE? <u>ALICE</u>: Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed

"Poverty"

Federal Poverty Level is set nationally for the contiguous 48 states (minus Hawaii and Alaska).

"ALICE Threshold"

Minimum income that a household needs to afford basic living costs based on household composition, specific to the locality.

"ALICE"

Household income *above* Federal Poverty Level but *below* the ALICE Threshold.






ALICE in Virginia

Of Virginia's 3,300,111 households in 2021...

- **10%** (338,028 households) earned below the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- **28%** (911,704 households) were ALICE households that earned above the FPL but below the ALICE Threshold for their locality
- **38%** (1,249,732 households) were living Below the ALICE Threshold (FPL + ALICE)
- **62%** (2,050,379 households) earned Above the ALICE Threshold






Figure 5. Income and Expenses, Family of Four, Virginia, 2021





ALICE Assistance Fund

- ALIC**E** Get to work, Stay at work
 - Employed at least an average of 20 hours per week
 - Income eligibility
 - Minimum = 100% of Federal Poverty Level
 - Maximum = ALICE Threshold for Household
- Financial Hardship in past 6 months
 - Qualifying events & circumstances:
 - Loss of employment, reduction in hours
 - Absence of primary income earner (separation, death)
 - Serious medical issue, injury or diagnosis
 - Significant unexpected increase in expenses


