## **Summary:**

ARRISONE

This public hearing is required by HUD to receive citizen comments on an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant 2021 Action Plan. Staff proposes that the following amendment be me made:

• \$50,000 will be transferred from the CDBG project 2021 Administration to the NEW CDBG project 2021 North Liberty Gateway Public Art.

Staff will make a short presentation, to be followed by a public hearing and a 30-day public comment period. There is no action needed on this item at this time.

### **Background:**

City staff is proposing that the council consider launching the process for the creation of an art installation at the convergence of North Main and Liberty Streets, located at the northern end of Downtown Harrisonburg. This proposed project will involve the collaboration of several community organizations and city departments. The Arts Council of the Valley has agreed to donate their time and expertise towards the oversight of this project. Harrisonburg Downtown Renaissance (HDR) has committed funding towards the art installation. Both the Community Development Block Grant and Public Works will also give time and staff resources towards this project.
