Background

May 2016: Virginia Statistics (courtesy Virginia DOC Monthly Population Summary)

Average of 30,183 offenders incarcerated in 43 state institutions, field units and work centers

60,359 on probation and parole or detention and diversion centers

Close to 95% of offenders incarcerated in Virginia will be released

Recidivism: Offenders re-arrested, reconvicted or re-incarcerated within three years of release 72 local or regional jails in Virginia

Population Average of 27, 473 inmates (courtesy State Compensation Board)

Approximately 2,000 arrestees are booked and classified into Rockingham Regional Jail annually

Real and urgent needs for vital transitional services, including housing, transportation, employment, and mental health, substance abuse or medical care


