RE: Franchise for use of sidewalk at South Main Street and Newman Avenue

<u>Summary:</u> Consider approving a franchise for a term in excess of five years to use, occupy, and alter the sidewalk at the along the north side of Newman Avenue, at the corner of Newman Avenue and South Main Street.

<u>Background:</u> The City has received a request to modify the sidewalk area along Newman Avenue, for the benefit of the building located at 122 South Main Street. The applicant has agreed, as a condition of the franchise, to enter into a maintenance agreement, whereby the applicant will be responsible for any maintenance and repair associated with the modified sidewalk area.

As proposed, in order to accommodate the alterations to the sidewalk area, one (1) of the four (4) street parking spaces will be removed.

Per Sec. 2-1-11 of the City Code, a franchise shall be valid only if passed by the council by a recorded affirmative vote of at least four (4) members.
