RE: HUD FY-2015 CDBG Amendment

Summary: \$66,259.70 that was allocated to the 2015 Administration Project (16CDBG05) will be moved to the Price Rotary Senior Center Renovation project (16CDBG04).

Background: In the 2015 CDBG Plan Year, the Parks and Recreation Department was awarded \$143,740.30 in CDBG funds to renovate the Price Rotary Senior Center. Bids for this project were received in January 2017 and were higher than originally anticipated. Staff is requesting that \$66,259.70 in excess funding from the 2015 CDBG Administration fund be moved to the 2015 Senior Center renovation project. This will bring the total available CDBG funds for this project to \$210,000.

Key Issues: A thirty day public comment period is required to complete this funding adjustment. The public comment period ended on March 20, 2017

Environmental Impact: An environmental review has been conducted in accordance with CDBG regulations.

Fiscal Impact: CDBG funds operate outside of the city's general budget. The grant is a reimbursement grant, so funds must be expended from the city's accounts prior to reimbursement from HUD.

Prior Actions:

- February 14, 2017 – This item was brought before council for a public hearing and the 30 day public comment period commenced.
- May 2015 – Council approved the CDBG 2015 Action Plan that included funding for the Price Rotary Senior Center project in the amount of \$143,740.30.
