Dear Mr. Fletcher:

I am writing as counsel for Trenton, Inc. and a related entity Bernard, LC (the "Applicant") who together own all the parcels surrounding an approximately 7,245 square foot alley located off of Warren Street in the City of Harrisonburg. The Applicant is requesting a closure and sale of the subject alley per the attached application and plat, and has offered to purchase the square footage at the valuation provided by the City Commissioner of Revenue's Office. The subject alley, as shown on the plat, provides not public access to another public street at its terminus, nor does it provide access to any properties other than those by the Applicant. The sole exception being the City owned parcels fronting South Liberty Street adjacent to its intersection with Warren Street, where a gravel parking area is currently located. The Applicant has agreed to provide the City an easement for access to these parcels and lot at the time of the closure and transfer of the alley to the Applicant.

The requested closure will also allow the Applicant to add the land comprising the existing alley to its adjoining parcels to foster future development opportunities, which would result in additional benefits to the City from the potential future development from increased assessments and higher land uses.

Thank you for the City's consideration of the alley closure request.
