## ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 3-1-3, 5-3-2 and 14-1-42(b) OF THE HARRISONBURG CITY CODE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA:

That Section 3-1-3 be amended and re-enacted as follows:

## Sec. 3-1-3. - Deputy city manager.

- (a) The city manager shall appoint a deputy city manager, whose term of office shall be at the pleasure of the city manager.
- (b) The deputy city manager shall perform the duties of the city manager in his absence and all other duties as may be assigned to him by the city manager. During the tenure of the deputy city manager, he shall reside within the city.

That Section 5-3-2 be amended and re-enacted as follows:

## Sec. 5-3-2. - Coordination of office.

Pursuant to § 44-146.19 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the functions and duties of the office of emergency management shall be carried out by the city manager, serving as the director of emergency management, the deputy city manager, serving as the deputy director of emergency management, and by the fire chief who, pursuant to chapter 2 of this title, shall serve as the coordinator of emergency management. The city manager may appoint a deputy coordinator, as he deems appropriate. City officials serving in the office of emergency management shall carry out their duties in consultation with the mayor or his representative from city council, as the circumstances permit.

That Section 14-1-42(b) be amended and re-enacted as follows:

## Sec. 14-1-42(b) - Hearings by council as to renewals, etc.

(b) To assist the city council in its decision making process, there is hereby established a standing committee comprised of the deputy city manager, the chief of police, the director of public transportation and one (1) representative from each company who is involved in the privately operated public transportation industry. The industry representatives shall be nonvoting members of the committee, shall be appointed by the council, and shall serve a four (4) year term. Such committee shall review applications for new and renewal certificates of public convenience, keeping in mind the requirements of this article B, and shall make recommendations based on its review to the council.
