### What is 4-H?





- Positive Youth Development Ages 5-19
- Largest Out-of-School Youth Organization in U.S.
  - Only federally approved and organized youth development organization
  - 188,563 Virginia 4-H Members Enrolled in 2017
- Learn By Doing, Age Appropriate
- Mission Mandates
  - Healthy Living
  - Science, Engineering, and Technology
  - Citizenship



#### What is 4-H?





- FREE
- Connection to Land Grant Universities
- Broad Reach 108 Units (counties and cities)
  - Lynchburg 2,239 youth members
  - Albemarle/Charlottesville 2,953 youth members
  - Richmond 9,322 youth members
- 13 Delivery Modes community clubs, after-school clubs, project clubs, camping (overnight and day)
- Volunteers as extenders of knowledge

#### 4-H Research

4-H participation increases confidence, independence, resilience, and compassion within youth.



- 2x more likely to get better grades in school
- 2x more likely to plan to go to college
- Females are 2x more likely to pursue science careers
- 2x more likely to exercise and be physically active
- 3x more likely to actively contribute to their communities
