RE: Resolution to allow credit card payments over the counter for Water Bills

<u>Summary:</u> The resolution states that the City will be allowing the payment of water bills, parking tickets, and tax bills over the counter and allow a convenience fee to be attached to the charge.

<u>Background:</u> VISA will not allow localities to accept Utility Bill payments over the counter with convenience fees attached. Passing the resolution will let VISA accept these payments.

## **Key Issues:**

- The City already allows payment over the counter for several other fee types.
- We already have convenience fees attached to Parking Ticket, Business License, Personal Property, Real Estate, and Water Bill payments made online.
- The Treasurer's office as well as the Water Operations Center will be allowed to start taking credit card payments over the counter once the resolution has been passed and the technology placed on site (estimated November 2021).
- ACI Worldwide recently lowered water bill convenience fees from \$4.50 to \$2.25.
