2. Liberty St between Rock St and Gay St

Due to the geometry of the intersection of Rock St, Noll Dr, and Liberty St, and the reality that right turns from Rock St onto Liberty St would not be legal in any configuration, staff have determined that the existing configuration of Liberty St between Rock St and Gay St is appropriate. Public Works staff will continue to evaluate and pursue the reconfiguration of Gay St to provide bike lanes.

3. Shared Use Path Naming

Staff will provide an overview of the process to name the path currently referred to as the Garbers Church Rd Shared Use Path.

4. S. Main St pedestrian safety concerns near South Ave

Staff were contacted with concerns about pedestrians crossing S. Main St near South Ave leading to dangerous situations due to the speed of vehicles on S. Main St.

5. Mason St speeding concerns

Staff have been contacted by residents who live on Mason St who report increased speeding on Mason St over the past months.

6. Northeast Neighborhood Intersection Safety improvements

Staff will provide an update and a few adjustments to the intersection safety improvements that were previously presented. The relevant intersections are Wolfe St & Sterling St, Gay St & Sterling St, and Gay St & Hill St.
