- Pilot of Housing Fund
- Being Done Elsewhere
- Provide Gap Financing
- open application RFP
- Solicit ideas Widely
- tell developers what city wants
 - Housing Vision
 - Eligible Uses

Residential Tax Abatement

- State Code Allows for Substantial Renovation, rehabilitation, or replacement
- Properties At least 15 years old
- Affordability not a requirement

Policy direction needed from Council

- Duration
- Depth
- Location
- Unit Types
- Income / Affordability





Fee Waivers

- Construction, Renovation, or Rehabilitation
- Nonprofit & private sector for affordable housing
- Fees Cover Real Costs → financial impact analysis
