RE: VDOT Urban Maintenance Program Mileage Deletions

<u>Summary:</u> The City is requesting the deletion of 0.80 lane miles of Collector/Local Streets be incorporated into VDOT's Urban Maintenance Program. Streets that will be deleted by this resolution are portions Shank Drive, Villa Drive, Hawthorne Circle, Pine Court, and Spruce Court.

<u>Background:</u> Through the Urban Maintenance Program the City receives quarterly payments based upon a formula that is based on street lane miles. These payments are used by Public Works for routine maintenance activities associated with the streets in the City. It should be noted that the maintenance formula is based only on traveling lane miles for motorized vehicles.

The streets being requested to be deleted are streets that were vacated and maintenance responsibilities were transferred to the Park Village, INC, by City Council action on July 11, 2017.

Environmental Impact: None.

<u>Fiscal Impact:</u> Based on the current VDOT maintenance payment allocations for FY18 of \$12,365/lane mile for Collector/Local Streets, these deletions will decrease the City's annual maintenance payment by \$9,892 per year. In FY18 the City will receive \$4,832,855.54 from the VDOT Urban Maintenance Program.
