<u>Summary:</u> Proposed amendments to Title 7, Chapter 3, "Sewer System," to bring Harrisonburg City Code in line with Harrisonburg-Rockingham Regional Sewer Authority (HRRSA) Operating Rules and Regulations.

Background: Under the March 4, 1985 Interjurisdictional Pretreatment Agreement between HRRSA and the City of Harrisonburg, the Authority and Harrisonburg must periodically review their respective regulations and ordinances and jointly draft and adopt equivalent amendments to their respective regulations and ordinances when necessary to ensure the effective administration and operation of the pretreatment program.

On May 1, 2018, new HRRSA Operating Rules and Regulations went into effect. These amendments to Title 7, Chapter 3 bring the City's relevant ordinances in line with HRRSA's regulations.
