WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Virginia now prioritizes transportation projects for funding based on the cost effectiveness of those projects to meet performance goals, as established by the Smart Scale program; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL desires to submit an application for an allocation of funds for the Carlton Street Improvements project under the Smart Scale prioritization program; and

WHEREAS, Carlton Street is identified in the VTRANS 2040 Needs Assessment as part of the Regional Network; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL understands this project to include the addition of a center turn lane, sidewalks on both sides, drainage improvements, and relocation of utility poles on Carlton Street between Market Street and Reservoir Street, which will improve safety, congestion, accessibility, and complete missing pieces in the sidewalk network; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are adopted in the City's 2011 Comprehensive Plan and the Harrisonburg Rockingham Metropolitan Planning Organization's Long Range Transporation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby supports this application for the improvements described to compete for state and federal funding under the Smart Scale program.
