RE: Eastern Raw Waterline Project

<u>Summary:</u> Consider a resolution to permit the City to use condemnation proceedings to acquire necessary easements for the Eastern Raw Waterline Project.

Background: The Public Utilities Department has successfully secured most of the real estate interests needed for the Eastern Raw Waterline Project. However, one land owner has thus far rejected the City's offers to purchase the needed interests. Another landowner has reached an agreement with the City but closing on the needed property interest has not occurred. This resolution enables the City to use condemnation proceedings if necessary to acquire the remaining needed real estate interests. The Public Utilities Department will continue its efforts to secure the needed interests through good faith negotiations. Council held a public hearing on this resolution on July 24, 2018. At that public hearing, the landowner with whom the City has not reached an agreement informed Council that an independent appraisal had been commissioned. Thus far no appraisal has been received from the landowner.
