RE: Opportunity Zones

<u>Summary:</u> The Economic Development Dept looks forward to this opportunity to share an overview of the federal Opportunity Zone Program with City Council.

Background: The federal government, as part of the 2017 Tax Act, adopted Opportunity Zones as a new federal incentive tool to help promote investment within approved census tracts.

Key Issues: Harrisonburg has two approved Opportunity Zones – one in the northeast section of the City and a southern zone, situated between Route 11 and Route 42. See map in attached prospectus.

Environmental Impact: This program offers federal tax advantages to investors within these zones.

<u>Fiscal Impact:</u> Capital gains tax benefits are available for investors within the zones. There are no fiscal impacts on local taxes.
