RE: Real Estate Tax Rate Public Hearing

Summary: Public hearing regarding the real estate tax rate for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 to be set at \$0.86 per \$100 of assessed value.

<u>Background:</u> The January 1, 2019 general reassessment of real property, performed by the Commissioner of the Revenue's office, resulted in an increase of 2.7 percent in real property assessments in the city. This 2.7 percent increase excludes increases in assessments due to new construction or improvements to property.

Key Issues: Pursuant to Section 58.1-3321 of the Code of Virginia, a public hearing must be held when a general reassessment of real property (excluding new construction) results in an increase of one percent or more in the total real property tax levy. In addition, the real estate tax rate is being proposed to increase \$0.01 per \$100 of assessed value to \$0.86 per \$100 of assessed value.

Environmental Impact: None

<u>Fiscal Impact:</u> It is anticipated that the general reassessment increase of 2.7 percent combined with the proposed tax rate increase of \$0.01 per \$100 of assessed value will provide approximately \$1,374,000 in additional real estate tax revenue for Fiscal Year 2019-2020.

Prior Actions: None

Alternatives: None

Community Engagement: A public hearing notice was placed in the Daily News-Record (DNR) on April 13, 2019.

Recommendation: Recommend approval of the advertised real estate tax rate to be \$0.86 per \$100 of assessed value for Fiscal Year 2019-2020.
