WHEREAS, on May 31, 2019, a gunman opened fire at his coworkers with the City of Virginia Beach and others; and

WHEREAS, 12 innocent people were tragically killed in this mass shooting, and others, including a law enforcement officer, were wounded; and

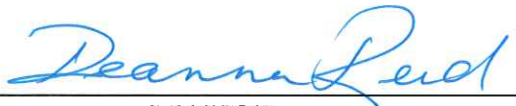
WHEREAS, many of the victims were public servants, dedicated to supporting their community and making Virginia a better place for all; and
