Summary: Consider amending City Code Section 3-1-2.

Background: Currently City Code Section 3-1-2 provides authority to the City Manager to execute all contracts and agreements. Staff believes that providing the City Manager the authority to also establish thresholds and delegate signature authority is more efficient for day-to-day operations. The proposed contract thresholds would be consistent with the city's purchasing thresholds.

Key Issues: The proposed contract thresholds to be establish are the following:

Contracts equal to or less than \$10,000 Contracts \$10,001 to \$60,000 Contracts equal to or more than \$60,000* DMV titled vehicles and/or equipment Task orders under existing contract Department Director or Designee Procurement Manager or Designee City Manager or Deputy City Manager Fleet Manager or Designee Department Director or Contract Manager

*All contracts over \$60,000 must first come to Purchasing. Purchasing will obtain City Manager's signature and return contract to department.
