RE: Supplemental Appropriation – Various Department Grants

**Summary:** Consider a supplemental appropriation for various departments in the amount of \$361,054.

**Background:** Several departments have been awarded grants. This request will appropriate these funds into the respective department budgets. These funds may only be used for the intended purposes of the grants.

## Key Issues:

- The Police Department was awarded a Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding grant through Department of Justice (DOJ) from the CARES Act in the amount of \$\$47,450.

- The City's Registrar's office was awarded CARES Act funding through the Department of Elections in the amount of \$67,204 to be used for COVID-19 related costs for the upcoming presidential election.

The Public Works Department was awarded additional VDOT funding in the amount of \$36,400 for Park Road project.
 ECC was awarded funding from the Virginia 9-1-1 Services Board in the amount of \$210,000 for the implementation of the upcoming NG9-1-1 project.

## Environmental Impact: None

**Fiscal Impact:** This action will increase the General Fund budget by \$114,654, the General Capital Projects Fund budget by \$36,400 and the ECC Capital Projects Fund by \$210,000.
