RE: Percentage of Personal Property Tax Relief for the Year 2020

Summary: The Commissioner of the Revenue and Finance Director have determined that the final percentage of personal property tax relief for the year 2020 to be twenty-four and four tenths percent (24.4%).

Background: The Personal Property Tax Relief Act of 1998 provides tax relief for any passenger car, motorcycle, pickup or panel truck having a registered gross weight of less than \$10,000 pounds and used for non-business purposes or registered with light duty pickup license plates. The \$1,522,583 the city receives from the Commonwealth each year must be spread among the qualifying vehicles.

Key Issues: In 2020, the total assessed value of qualifying vehicles was \$187,525,781. There were 2953 vehicles with values of \$1,000 or less, 24,053 vehicles with values of \$1,001 to \$20,000 and 1,699 vehicles with values greater than \$20,000.
