



Report Date Daily Cases Counts - Harrisonburg




Harrisonburg Weekly Case Count



Rockingham Weekly Case Count




Harrisonburg/Rockingham Cases by Week









  - **Deaths: 2 (6%)**


Cases by Age Group - New River




Cases by Age Group - Central Shenandoah
