Why do you wish to serve on a board or commission?

I've worked as a psychiatric and mental health nurse, for over 20 years, and a family nurse practitioner for the past 8 years. The majority of my career has been spent serving vulnerable populations who are navigating mental health or substance abuse issues. I teach Nursing and the the impact of Chronic Illness to health science students, and part of the education that I provide to them is their civic duty to bring their knowledge base and skills to civic engagement in their communities, and would therefore like to "practice what I preach" in service to the Harrisonburg Community.

What relevant experience or education do you have to this board or commission?

I will finish my Doctorate of Nursing degree in December 2020. I have a Master's Degree in Nursing, am certified as a Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse, and a Family Nurse Practitioner. My research and focus areas have been psychiatric and mental health issues, advocacy and engagement, social and environmental justice, adverse childhood experiences, trauma informed care, creative, supportive housing and homelessness, healthcare reform. I have worked in the psychiatric and mental health arena in community hospitals, as a home health and hospice nurse, in the private practice setting, and for the community services board. I have developed programs to serve social and health care needs of older adults, individuals navigating severe and chronic mental health and substance abuse issues, and individuals requiring acute inpatient services on behavioral health units. I take students to our local state mental health hospital for clinical practicum, and am very familiar with a variety of treatment and service models inpatient and outpatient. I volunteer with the JMU Suitcase clinic which serves the homeless population those recently released or diverted from incarceration. I have worked in utilization review and quality assurance, and have experience in community outreach, liaison with multiple stakeholders and interests, procedure and policy writing, staff training and fiscal responsibility. I served on the Local Human Rights Committee.

What other interests or concerns do you have regarding the community?

I have interests, creative ideas, commitment and concerns about enhancing inclusive, accountable preventative, and restorative, sustainable behavioral health, housing, social services and well-being for all members of the Harrisonburg community. I would like to lend my energy and skill towards amplifying access to quality, equitable, timely, client centered resources that are fiscally responsible, I think that Harrisonburg is a fantastic place to call home. I believe that we have an incredibly engaged, innovative and committed community and that we have substantial opportunity for creative collaborations as we work to achieve sustainable development goals.
