RE: Amendment to City Code Section 11-1-9, Board of building code appeals

Summary: Proposed amendments to Section 11-1-9 (Board of building code appeals) to bring Board of Building Code Appeals membership in line with state recommendations.

<u>Background:</u> Building Code Section 119.2 recommends local boards of building code appeals have at least five members, and further recommends the membership be composed of at least one: experience builder, experienced property manager, and registered design professional (licensed architect or professional engineer).

Current Section 11-1-9 requires the Board of Building Code Appeals (BBCA) consist of 9 members, including at least one: architect, professional engineer, property manager, experienced builder, person experienced in fire prevention, master plumber, master HVAC mechanic, and master electrician.

Key Issues: Keeping the BBCA's membership full has been difficult, given the large number of members and the wide, specific array of professional background qualifications. A change in the required composition of its membership and number of members will facilitate processing future appeals in a timely and efficient manner.
