Moving here from Dubai, I was struck by the tremendous natural beauty of the area, and of the likelihood of growth in future decades. I also noticed that the housing is very low-density and completely reliant on cars, which means that the area will probably sprawl out into the countryside a great deal as the population grows. I saw that giant retail chains seem to have somehow gained an advantage in development, especially on major corridors like US-33. I wondered if there might be opportunities to help nurture the growth of home-grown businesses, and to make the city more unique and more walkable, which could also help create a tourism industry down the road. I'd love to make a contribution if I can somehow.

## What relevant experience or education do you have to this board or commission?

- —Back in the 90s, I served on State of Minnesota committees while a state employee. I understand how government works at the state level in another mostly agrarian state. (I was an officer in the Depts. of Finance and Administration.) —Since attending a charrette in Bluffton, SC about 15 years ago, I have been working to learn theory on zoning and planning by following the work of a variety of groups such as The Congress for The New Urbanism, Strong Towns and the World Economic Forum.
- —Having been based in a global airline hub, Dubai, for over a decade, I had a rare chance to visit cities all around the world on 5 different continents. This gave me an unusual opportunity to see many the results of many different ways that communities solve problems together.
- —I am brand new to the area, which I think could be helpful to the city in that I have not had time to get used to the way things "always have been." I still have fresh ideas from having spent a great deal of time in different cities and towns around the world, especially in Europe.
