Through the Urban Maintenance Program the City receives quarterly payments based upon a formula that is based on street lane miles. These payments are used by Public Works for routine maintenance activities associated with the streets in the City. It should be noted that the maintenance formula is based only on traveling lane miles for motorized vehicles.
