This ordinance would limit the number of persons at private or public events to 50. The ordinance is an emergency ordinance which would be in effect until 11:59 pm December 13, 2020 unless extended by Council. The ordinance exempts religious activities, weddings, expressive activities, commercial establishments and non-profit organizations. The ordinance provides penalties for violations, specifically the owner or tenant of the property could be charged with a Class 3 misdemeanor and subject to a fine of up to \$500.00, and attendees would be subject to a fine of up to \$250.00 as a class 4 misdemeanor. Charges would not be placed unless an individual receives a warning from a law enforcement officer and refuses to disperse.
