Eastern Mennonite University is requesting the closure of Park Rd from Mt Clinton Pike to Parkwood Dr from 8am-3:30pm on Saturday, May 1st during spring commencement exercises.

As in previous years, Harrisonburg Public Works will provide a message board at the Ballfield on Mount Clinton Pike and drop off barricades. EMU staff and volunteers will place barricades and help manage the closure of Park Rd.
